Mr. Pottier joined Crédit Agricole SA Group as Global Head of Sustainable Development in 2011 and was member of the Group Management Committee in 2017. Since June 2018, Stanislas Pottier is Chief Responsible Investment Officer of Amundi and member of the Executive Committee.

He is also Board Member of several NGOs and Think Tanks, chairing BBKA, an NGO advocating for Low Carbon Building, and FXB-France, fighting deep poverty in the world.
